To capture up-close and in-focus shots, hold the camera at an arms length and then zoom in. This technique ensures clarity and enables Dr. Reed to assess your anatomy accurately.
2. **Multiple Angles and Perspectives:** To gain a comprehensive understanding, we recommend taking photos from different angles. This allows us to assess your situation from various perspectives. While the minimum number of photos is specified below, you may send more if you feel it's necessary.
3. **Optional Edits to Highlight Concerns:** If you have specific areas of concern, you can mark them for Dr. Reed's attention. Feel free to send a second copy of any photo, with edits such as arrows or circles, to highlight those bothersome areas. This visual aid will provide clarity during the evaluation process.

Labiaplasty/Clitoral Hood Procedures

Dr. Reed needs a minimum of 5 photos. Photos #1 through #4 should be taken while sitting or lying down.

1. Legs widely apart
2. Legs just open enough to fit the camera/phone in between
3. Lateral (from the left or right)
4. Opposing lateral (left or right)
5. Should be taken while standing

Vaginal Reconstruction/Rejuvenation

Dr. Reed needs a minimum of 3 photos. All photos should be taken while sitting or lying down. If you will be adding labiaplasty/clitoral hood reduction, please also follow the above instructions

1. Legs just open enough to fit the camera/phone in between
2. Legs widely apart
3. Legs widely apart and you using your fingers to separate your labia and expose your vaginal opening as much as possible
